
A BIG welcome back to everyone. It is so lovely to see our new children in Reception and Nursery settling in well and of course looking so smart in their school uniform.

CATENDANCE Matters	We regularly remind our parents/carers about the importance of good attendance and punctuality. You may be surprised to know that the Nationally expected level of attendance is 96% and above which equates to a child being absent for only 7 school days in a school year. Every day lost at school affects children's learning and achievement and it is important that we work hard to ensure that children do not 'miss out'. For this reason work they have missed at school will be sent home with them when they return to school to complete and return to school. The support of our parents/carers with this matter is very important to us and much appreciated.
