

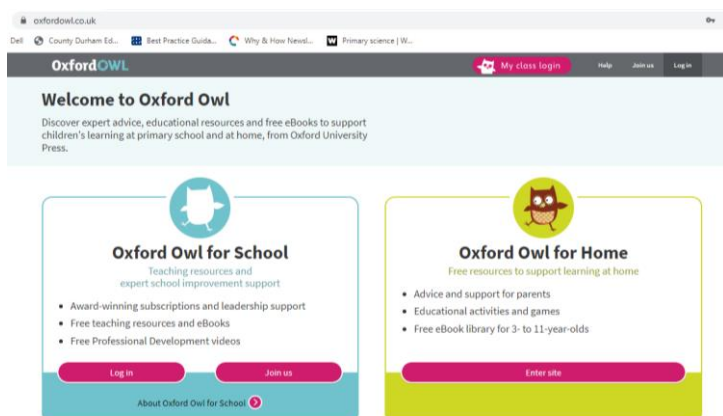


Reading during the school closure

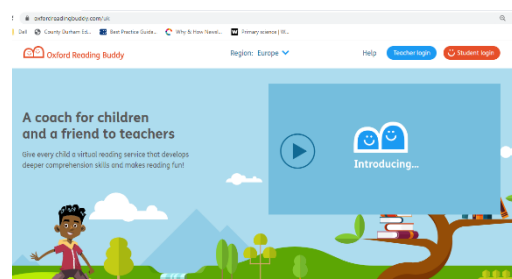

e.g. joeb

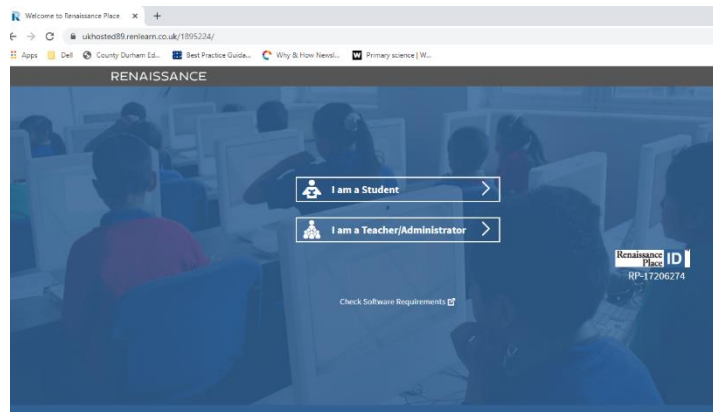
Password for all children: fish1

School Code: bmcaw

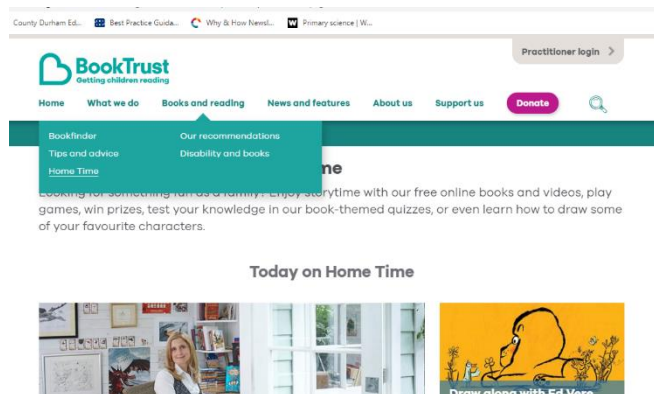
