


Walking Home

- Please record reading in your child's planner.
- Please sign your child's planner at the end of the week.
- Reading books will be changed weekly.





New Weekly Homework

- Starting next week your child receive additional maths and English homework that is compulsory.
- ▶ They will get a maths booklet and an English booklet to take home.
- Each week they will be asked to complete one maths test and one English test.
- The children will bring the booklets back to school each week and we will mark the answers as a class.
