Start times

Reminder our start time in September will be **8.45am** children can come into school from 8.30am and go straight to their class. The register closes at 8.50am any children in past 9am will be marked as late. Holidays cannot be authorised.

Holidays in term time

Holidays during term time of 5 days will be referred to the Local Authority for a Fixed Penalty Notice. A Leave of Absence form must be completed prior to any holidays.

Attendance

Expected attendance is 96% and we continue to keep parents informed regularly with attendance. The school is here to support and we will work with families in the best way possible. The biggest difference to a child's education, outcomes and successes in the future is good attendance. It is a parents responsibility to ensure your child is in school.

Uniform

Our uniform policy was sent out with the reports and is available on the website. Please can I remind parents/carers of the following:

- Trainers/shoes must be plain black
- Earrings must not be worn in September, and will need to be removed.
- Hairstyles children cannot wear styling products or have hair dyed/shaved or extreme styles. Long
 hair should be worn up with red/black/blue/brown bobbles. We will be strictly monitoring the
 Uniform Policy in September.

Water

Water bottles can only have water in. If your child does have flavoured water/fizzy drinks in, we will swap it for a school water bottle.

Book bags/Planners

Pupils will be given new book bags and planners in September.

PE Kit

Children do not require a PE kit. Suitable footwear for outside play is all that is required. PE kits are provided for sporting events.

Homework

Children are expected to read x5 per week and learn spellings and maths facts. We use extra learning times to support pupils if they need to do their reading or practise maths facts/spellings.

Communication

Teacher will respond to parent's emails within 24hours within working hours. Please note if it is a matter of urgency then it may be best to contact the school office between 8am and 3.30pm.
