




# Weardale Adventure Centre

A licence is only granted after a full inspection of the provider, with further inspections carried out each year.


# Award

The LOtC Quality Badge means that the holder has passed a robust assessment designed to ensure that they are meeting schools' learning and risk management needs, no matter what activities they offer.


# Centre Staff





# Bedrooms


- ▶ There are two floors.
